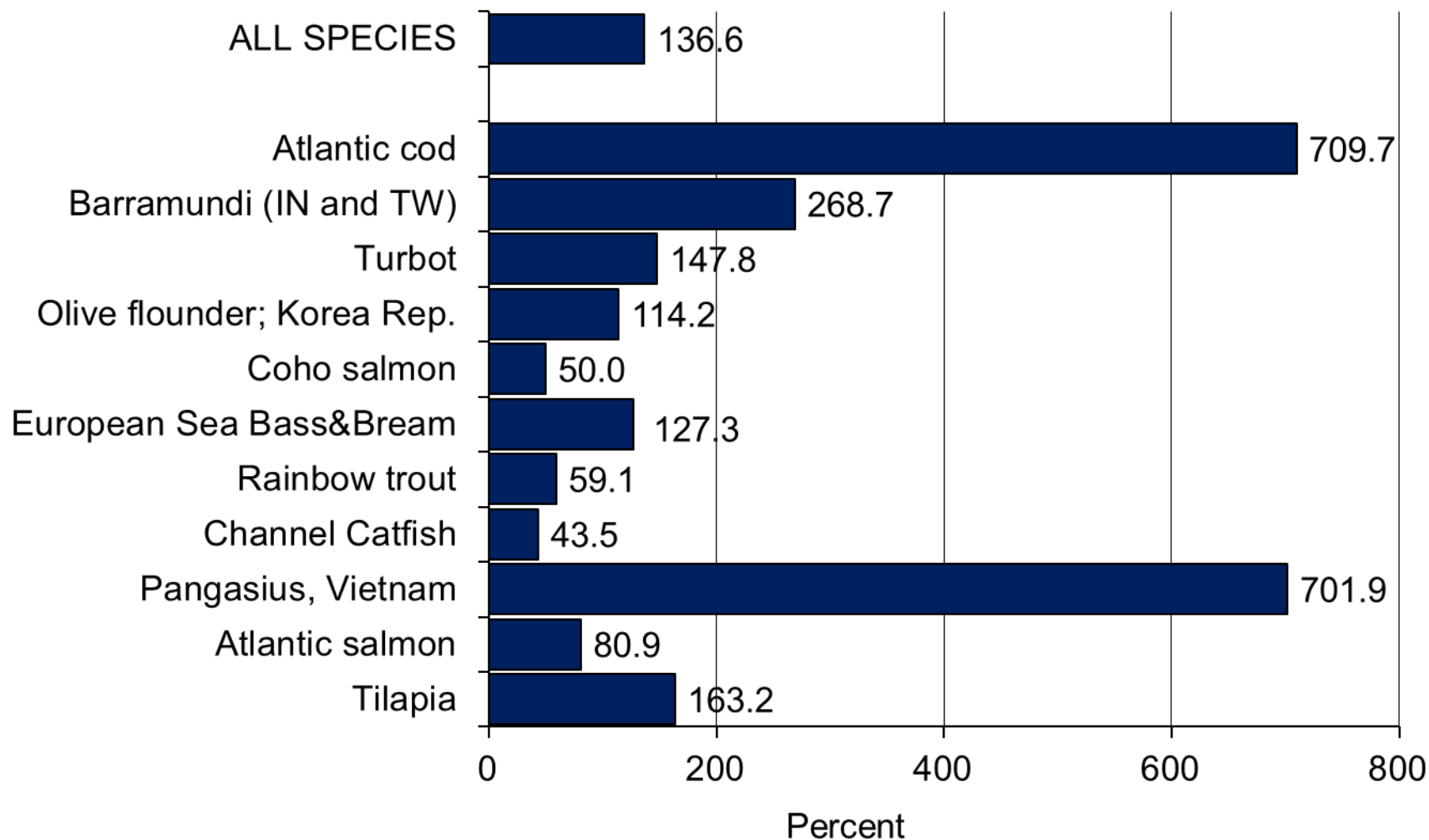
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Did finfish double in a decade? Yes!

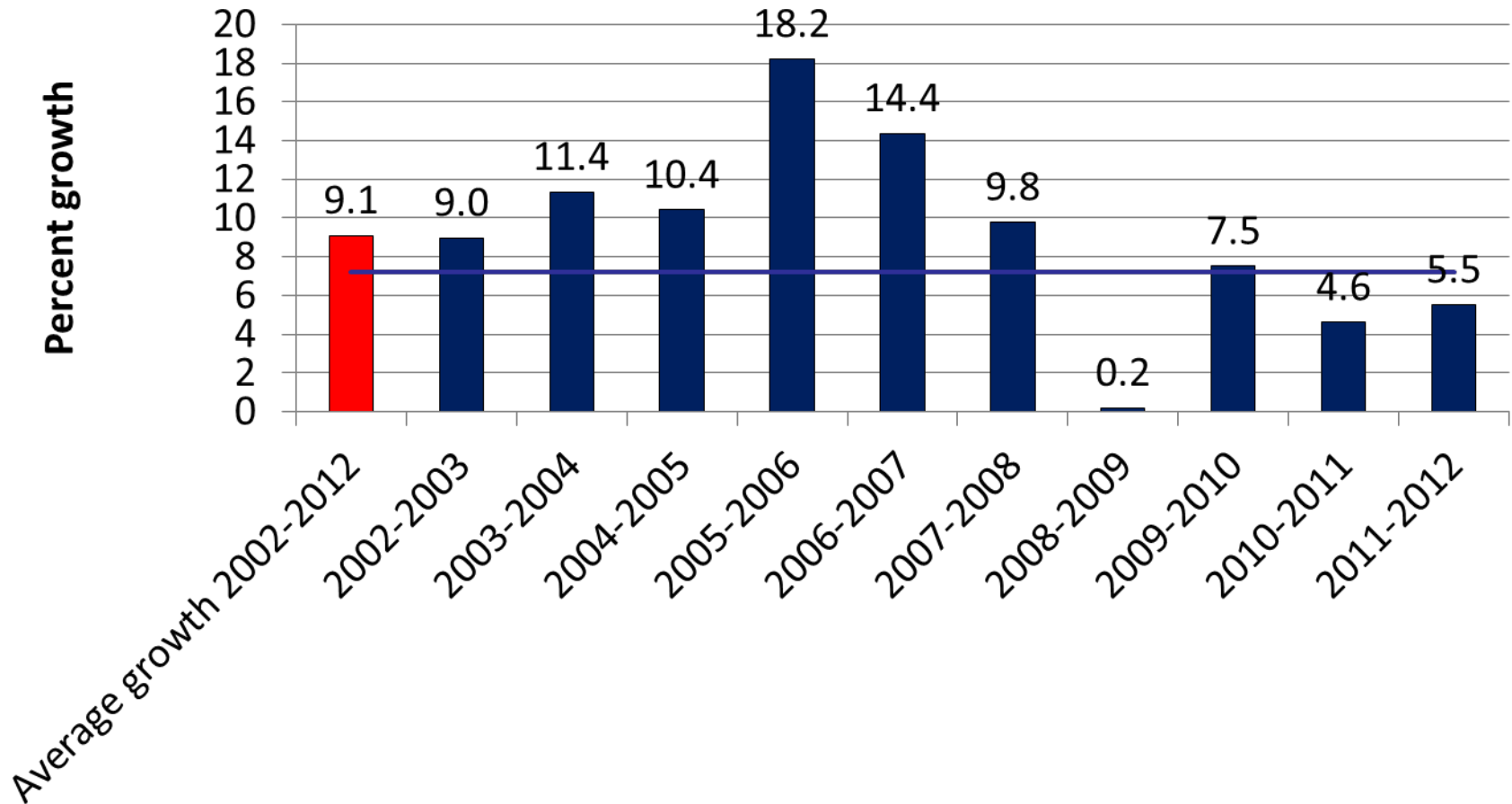
Percentage growth 2002-2012
